Senior Women's Selection Policy - Season 2011/12

In season 2011/12 the selectors will consist of the coach, captain and vice-captain.

Selectors will pick teams based on availability, taking into account total numbers, status of outstanding fees or any pending disciplinary matters.

All players who are dropped will be advised by the Selection Committee prior to publication of the teams.

If any players have complaints they should discuss their selection with the coach or captain in the first instance. If this is not an option or if not satisfied after the initial discussion, players should contact the Director of Cricket.

Players who train and contribute to the club will be viewed more favorably than those who don't.

Whilst the nature of the playing group may mean fill-in players will be required regularly and players may come and go, when all players are available for selection preference will be given to those who have trained regularly and played the majority of the season.

During the season, selectors will endeavour to give all players opportunities to demonstrate and develop their skills in match situations. Whilst this may not be every player, every week, best efforts will be made to give these opportunities regularly.

The following factors will be taken into account when selecting sides:

Individual performances

The selection committee will focus on all-round performances and will look at all aspects of play- batting, bowling and fielding. Players will be expected to consistently follow the team structure as outlined by the team captain or the coach. Team players will be preferred over individuals.

Attitude

Players are expected to display a positive attitude to the club, fellow players and administrators. This positive attitude should be displayed through effort at training and match days, timeliness of attendance, contribution to team spirit and performance and match day organization.

Training Attendance

Players are expected to attend training. If players cannot attend due to work/study commitments they must inform captains or coach at the commencement of the week.

Unavailability

If a player becomes unavailable after the sides are selected they are to personally advise either their Captain or coach of their unavailability, (and a reason) at the earliest possible time to allow a replacement to be arranged. Failure to do so could lead to the player being stood down for the following match.

If a player misses a game, they will not be automatically reselected in that grade. If warranted, the replacement will retain their position in the side.

Any player that refuses to play where selected will be stood down for that match, and will only be available again for selection after they have explained their actions to the selection committee.
